- There will be Napo 'stewards' around outside St Stephen's Entrance, in Central Lobby and outside the Committee room to assist and advise.

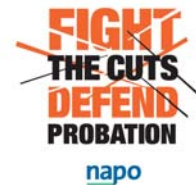
I would be grateful if this note could circulate to all members of Napo who are intending to come to the event on Monday 9th June.
